# **Survey Overview**



### **Purpose**

- Sent to students through a Canvas announcement, social media posts, and other related student communication channels
- Promoted through a video from the College President and Student Leaders

### **Level of Response**


338 total responses (about 7% of current students)

Given this history, please select below your preference with regard to the naming of the College





If Thomas Nelson Community College were to be renamed, which of the following would be your preference?




## **Naming of Hampton Campus Buildings**

# **Summary**



#### Naming of the College

- Overall, a slight majority of those who responded to the survey (52.9%) would like the College to retain the name Thomas Nelson Community College.
- The most popular option for a new name, if one were to be chosen, is one that represents the geographic area that the College serves.

#### **Naming of Hampton Campus Buildings**

• Overall, survey responses regarding the names of the five Hampton Campus buildings closely mirrored the responses for the name of the College. Depending on the specific building, between 51.4% and 54.1% of respondents felt the name should remain the same.

#### **Comparisons to Community Survey**

- Student preference similar
- Student-specific survey results less definitive in terms of preference on the name of the College (52.9% supported retaining the name, as compared to 67.7% in the community survey)
