

# **Thomas Nelson Community College Fact Book 2019-2020**

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The Fact Book for Thomas Nelson Community College is designed to report on credit instruction at the College and to provide key information on the College's students, the awards conferred by the institution and the characteristics of its graduates, and the courses and programs in which the College's students enroll. This information is organized into major sections, as outlined in the Table of Contents below. A table of information, including data from the five most recent academic years (where available), can be found within the Fact Book for each item listed in the Table of Contents. At Thomas Nelson Community College, academic years include the fall and spring semesters and the preceding summer term.

The primary sources of information for the Fact Book are the official Virginia Community College System Annual Unduplicated Enrollment and Graduate files.

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# **Introduction: About the College**

Thomas Nelson Community College, one of 23 colleges within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), is a comprehensive, public, two-year community college. The College enrolled its first 1,232 students in Fall 1968 at its Hampton Campus. In 2003, the College officially established the Historic Triangle Campus to serve students in the Greater Williamsburg area.

Thomas Nelson's current mission statement is as follows: Thomas Nelson Community College changes lives, empowers students to succeed, and enhances the civic and economic vitality of the Peninsula community through high quality education and workforce training, excellent services, and innovative partnerships. The College serves the Virginia Peninsula, encompassing the cities of Hampton, Newport News, Poquoson, and Williamsburg, and the counties of James City and York, in southeast Virginia. Thomas Nelson is an open enrollment institution; students are eligible for admission to Thomas Nelson if they are high school graduates or the equivalent, or if they are 18 years of age or older and able to benefit academically from study at the College, as demonstrated by assessment in reading, writing, and mathematics.

In Academic Year 2019-2020, Thomas Nelson served 10,892 students (unduplicated headcount) in credit instruction, making it the fifth largest college within the Virginia Community College System in terms of headcount. The College serves a highly diverse region, and its student body closely reflects the demographics of the greater community. Of the College's 10,892 credit students, 59.7% are female and 66.8% are under the age of 25. By race/ethnicity, 47.9% of students are White, 29.3% are Black or African American, 9.0% are Hispanic, and the remaining 13.7% identify as another race or as two or more races, or did not specify their race/ethnicity.

Traditionally underserved populations, as defined by student race/ethnicity, first-generation status, and Pell Grant receipt, comprise 62.4% of the College's unduplicated credit headcount.

Additionally, the College's students have a variety of educational goals. Of its 10,892 credit students in 2019-2020, 46.1% were enrolled in transfer degree programs; 24.6% were enrolled in applied degree programs, certificate programs, or career studies certificate programs; and 29.2% were non-curricular. Thomas Nelson serves a region that is home to many military service members and their families. In Academic Year 2019-2020, 25.1% of Thomas Nelson credit students indicated a military affiliation (e.g., active-duty, veteran, military spouse, or military dependent).

The College is committed to best serving its students and community, and is engaged in a five year strategic plan, titled *Focus 2020*, that is designed to advance the institution in the areas of excellence, partnership, and student success.

## **Definitions**

**Asynchronous class**: A class that lacks defined starting and ending times, such as independent studies or internships.

**Day class**: A class that begins before 6:00pm.

**Distance class**: A class that is taught entirely online.

**Evening class**: A class that begins at 6:00pm or later.

Full-time Equivalent Students (FTES): The sum of annual enrolled credit hours divided by 30.

**Full-time faculty**: A teaching faculty member that has a nine- or twelve-month contract; categorization comes from IPEDS HR data.

**Hampton student**: A student who enrolled in one or more classes that met on the Hampton campus.

**Historic Triangle student**: A student who enrolled in one or more classes that met on the Historic Triangle campus.

**Hybrid class**: A class with both distance and face-to-face components.

**Part-time faculty**: A faculty member without a full-time teaching contract; categorization comes from Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Human Resources data.

**Traditional class**: A class that meets entirely face-to-face.








